



TEACHERS' BILL OF RIGHTS

- You have the right to **pray** at times when you are not acting in an official capacity.
- You have the right to **read your Bible** at times when you are not acting in an official capacity.
- You have the right to **teach about religion** in your classroom.
- You have the right to **accommodate a student's religious rights**.
- You have the right to **neither encourage nor discourage** a student's participation in a religious club or class.
